Serviam Award	Two students from Year 6	<p>Award presented for consistently demonstrating and upholding the mission of the school. Through their actions they have lived “The Lourdes Way” and have made a significant contribution to maintaining the culture of the school. They have upheld the values of our school and have demonstrated the CALLED to Think traits of a learner and global citizen.</p> <p>Eligibility Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Staff and students nominate up to three students who demonstrate the Lourdes Way in Action• Leadership team consult with Year 6 teachers to consider top candidates from the nomination process• Final decision made by the Principal
Academic Excellence	Up to two students in each year level	<p>Presented in recognition of a consistently outstanding level of achievement, engagement, and application across all learning areas and class-based assessments throughout the school year.</p> <p>Eligibility Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The student has received the highest overall academic achievement• A majority of A or B Grades on both the Semester One and Semester Two report cards.• A majority of Excellent and Commendable Effort in both semesters. <p><i>NAPLAN and whole-school standardised test results may be considered to support the teacher's decision.</i></p>
Diligence Award	Up to six students from each year level	<p>Presented in recognition of a consistent high level of effort and dedication in all learning areas whilst maintaining a high level of academic achievement in class-based assessment throughout the school year.</p> <p>Eligibility Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A majority of A or B Grades on both the Semester One and Semester Two report cards.• A majority of Excellent and Commendable Effort in both semesters.



Enhancement of Learning Award	Up to six students from each year level	Awarded to the students, who through determination and consistent effort, have demonstrated significant growth and improvement in their schoolwork, throughout the school year. Eligibility Requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evidence reflected in report card growth• Evidence of growth in formative/summative assessments• Attitude and mindset reflect our school values and Called to Think
Athlete of the Year Award	One boy and one girl from Year 5 or Year 6	Awarded to students who have excelled in School Sport activities, including OLOL, West Zone, Darling Downs, and Queensland School Sport sanctioned events, and have represented their OLOL Sport House with pride and commitment.
Arts Award	Up to two students from each year level	Awarded to the students who have demonstrated a high level of effort and aptitude across all areas of the Arts and school-based productions or exhibitions. Consultation across all Arts subject teachers.
